Term Paper Writing Steps

Following are the steps to write a term paper:

1. Select a Topic

The first thing to do in college term paper writing is to select a topic that interests you. Sometimes instructors themselves give the topic and sometimes it is up to you to choose one. 2. **Do a Thorough Research**

Research is a prerequisite for writing any academic paper. Doing relevant and thorough research is also part of the assessment. Do not deviate from your stance and search for appropriate material from articles, books, journals, or other internet sources.

3. Clarify Your Thesis Statement

Clarifying your thesis statement is the foremost requirement of the term paper. It is your position on a certain topic that you refer to in the entire body paragraphs. The thesis consists of a claim and its rationale. Throughout the body paragraphs, you are supposed to give valid reasons and evidence to prove your thesis. You can provide a literature review to prove your thesis with deductions. Or you can share your own findings.

4. Construct an Outline for Your Paper

The organization of ideas is an essential part of writing a term paper at the college level. For that, an outline gives you a structure to follow. It organizes ideas in sequence and works as an effective tool to understand the flow of information. It makes sure that nothing is forgotten. Above all, it gives your teacher a look at your future term paper. 5. State Your Position in the Introduction

Writing an introduction is the most challenging part of term papers. It needs to be rewritten as you proceed to work on your paper. However, you should begin to write an introduction with the topic to be discussed in your paper. The significance of the problem or the topic is explained at hand. Then, the order of flow of discussion or information about the topic is written.

6. Write Convincing Body Paragraphs

It is necessary to make sure that each body paragraph supports your thesis statement in a novel way. The topic sentences of each paragraph should contain the main point and reason for supporting it. The paragraphs should then be followed by evidence that you find through research. You have to write both a review of the literature and your findings. Write a critical analysis of the research you have done so far related to the topic.

7. Reach a Conclusion

Restate your thesis statement and write a brief summary of your discussion. You have to state the limitations of research in your conclusion and way forwards. Do not end your paper by wrapping up everything. Leave a question for your reader so that one can continue research regarding a certain topic. Link your concluding paragraph with the introduction by including everything you discussed.

8. Add References

To uphold intellectual honesty, it is necessary to give credit to the sources from where you have taken information. Therefore, add references at the end of your term paper and do not miss any of the sources you have used so far. 9. Use Certain Formatting Style

To write an academic paper or term paper, your instructor guides you to write in a certain way. For instance, the instructor may ask you to use APA format, MLA, AMA, or Harvard, etc. They refer to the style of the title page; headings, and subheadings; font-size, and shape of the text; in-text citation, and referencing style.
